Any person addressing the Group under public comment will be limited to a 3-minute presentation to ensure that all interested parties have an opportunity to speak. Also, all persons addressing the Group must state their name and county of residence for the record.

Items of Interest

 Information on grants and loans being offered by California State agencies can be found on the California Grants Portal. It has details on funding that is offered on a competitive

- or first-come basis. The portal includes a feature to sign-up for email subscriptions to receive updates on funding in specific categories.
- Next week, the State Water Resources Control Board will begin accepting concept proposals for Round 3 of the <u>Proposition 1 Groundwater Grant Program</u>. The funding is for projects that cleanup or prevent aquifer contamination. Certain water projects serving disadvantaged communities will also be considered. Proposals will be accepted from Tuesday, July 6th, through Tuesday, September 7th.
- California lawmakers voted on Monday night to approve a record-busting state budget which includes \$1 billion over several years for wildfire prevention, \$3 billion to alleviate drought, and \$3.7 billion over three years to mitigate dangers posed by climate change. Newsom and legislative leaders are still figuring out how to spend the funds. Please click here to read the original article about this budget agreement.
- The Arbor Day Foundation and the National Fish & Wildlife Foundation (NFWF) have partnered to provide approximately \$1.2 million in funding to assist with post-fire reforestation needs and recovery. This funding is not limited to any particular jurisdictional boundaries or specific wildfire events. Details of the <u>program, application information</u>, <u>submittal deadlines</u>, and other information is available through the NFWF's website at <u>www.nfwf.org</u>. Proposal submissions are due on Wednesday, August 5, 2021.
- The Safe and Affordable Funding for Equity and Resilience (SAFER) Advisory Group is accepting applications for the 10 seats that are currently open. This group provides the State Water Board with advice on the Safe and Affordable Drinking Water Fund Expenditure Plan and other SAFER-related policies. Applications will be accepted through August 31, 2021. The application form can be found online by clicking here.
