Items of Interest

- The Cal OES Hazard Mitigation Assistance (HMA) has released a mitigation funding opportunity for FEMA's Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) as a result of the Presidential Major Disaster Declaration, DR-4683 (Severe Winter Storms, Flooding, Landslides, and Mudslides). This opportunity provides funding for communities to implement mitigation activities that reduce risk to life, property, and infrastructure from natural hazards. Natural hazards in CA include wildfire, earthquake, drought, extreme heat, flooding, and others as defined in the [State Hazard Mitigation Plan](#) (currently accepting public comments until March 24th). HMGP funding can support the develop of hazard mitigation plans, project scoping activities (i.e., Advance Assistance), and mitigation projects.

The full Notice of Funding Opportunity which includes eligibility, priorities, and timelines can be found on the [HMGP webpage](#). Notices of Interest are set to open on March 31st and close on May 10th. Subapplications are set to open on June 2nd and close on August 4th. Awards are expected to be made in early 2024.
