DWR announced that the Drought Resiliency Interagency and Partners (DRIP) Collaboration has released its [2024 progress report](#), highlighting the activities, discussions, meetings, and collaborative recommendation process undertaken during the [DRIP Collaborative's second year](#). The DRIP Collaborative was established under [Senate Bill 552](#) to enhance California's resilience to droughts and water shortages.

Focus areas for 2025 include land use planning for drought resilience, water infrastructure and planning, reducing ecosystem impacts of drought, climate change adaptation, and nature-based solutions for drought resilience.
