- Projects continue to move forward:
 - Project 2 GSP Updates is complete. Draft project completion report has been submitted to DWR for review.
 - Project 3 Madera WD is waiting on the DSOD permit. The project went out to bid. The bid opening is May 23rd.
 - Project 4 Complete.
 - Project 5 All field work has been completed, 30% of the plans are done, and the basis of design report is nearly complete. They expect the CEQA documents to be in public review by the end of June.
