## <u>Items of Interest</u> (Jacob Roberson)

- The Fall GSA Forum will be held on October 15<sup>th</sup>. DWR hosts these forums for GSA members and representatives, typically on a biannual basis, to act as a platform for local agencies to come together to engage and exchange ideas on topics related to GSP implementation, highlight various GSA efforts, foster professional networks, and provide an opportunity for DWR staff to identify high-priority GSA needs.
- The 5<sup>th</sup> biennial Flood-MAR Forum is currently open for registration. This is California's leading event on the use of floodwaters for managed aquifer recharge. The forum will be held on November 5<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> at the Harper Alumni Center, Sacramento State University.

 The launch of the <u>Groundwater Demand Management Network</u> was recently announced. The Network is a new statewide initiative designed to create a comprehensive community of practice for managing California's critical groundwater resources.

The Network has launched its California Groundwater Community Needs Assessment to help shape programming, identify priority needs, and establish partnerships across the state. The Network encourages all interested parties to take the <u>5-minute survey</u>. The survey should be completed by September 30<sup>th</sup>. The outcomes of the survey will prove invaluable to guide the services the Network will offer.
